However, I frequently mix techniques to bring resolution to the dispute. Specifically, I attempt to gain an understanding early regarding the personalities in the room, encourage the principals to do their own evaluation and problem-solving once they hear the positions of all parties. I ask questions to provoke thought processes, attempt to reduce adversarial dynamics that occur during the typical litigation process and empower the parties to take control of resolving the dispute on what terms they believe are best. Finally, I attempt to think “outside the box” when obstacles are created to hinder the settlement process.
